- An Artist Statement or Writer's Reflection
- Original work that reflects the 2025 theme:
 Feeding Connection: Learning from Country
- Please ensure the artwork photo is of high quality otherwise it can not be part of the exhibition.
- Written pieces can be uploaded as word documents
- Submission by the deadline: Friday 12
 September 2025
