
How to Submit

The Schools Reconciliation Challenge is a digital-first program. All entries—whether artworks, poems, or short stories—must be submitted online in digital format via our portal

Checklist for your submissions

Make sure each entry includes:

- ☐ A title and correct file naming > format: School_Title of the artwork_Students Name (e.g. BNPS_My Country_Mary Smith)
- ☐ An Artist Statement or Writer's Reflection
- ☐ Original work that reflects the 2025 theme: Feeding Connection: Learning from Country
- ☐ Please ensure the artwork photo is of high quality otherwise it can not be part of the exhibition.
- ☐ Written pieces can be uploaded as word documents
- ☐ Submission by the deadline: Friday 12 September 2025
